Our staff prepares to make this school year a promise for making plans to reach new goals, and a promise for supporting your child to fulfill those goals with our supportive and engaging learning environment for each child.

We begin a new school year with new staff members, innovative opportunities, and "fun" learning activities that will enhance their educational growth.

School opens on Wednesday, September 3rd for students. Your home district will be in touch with you pertaining to transportation pick up time. Warren Glen Academy does not set or schedule these times.

*The first three days of school (September 3, 4, and 5) are Early Dismissal days at **12:15 p.m.***

Monday, September 8 is a full day schedule with dismissal at **2:15 p.m.**

Please review the following items before we start the school year. This information remains consistent throughout the school year, and we ask for your support and cooperation in these matters to avoid unnecessary conflict/confrontation to maintain a harmonious school environment.

EMERGENCY CONTACT AND MEDICAL/MEDICINE INFORMATION

Kindly return medical information immediately. We need to provide this information to First Responders as well as the hospital in the event of an emergency with your child here at school. First Responders and the hospital need to have reliable information to contact the family and to avoid a medical reaction.

PLEASE keep your child's information up to date which includes emergency contacts, medication changes, allergies, diagnosis, and any other medical conditions.

Please keep our nurse informed of all medical updates.

In the event of an emergency, you **MUST** have reliable transportation available. Please have a plan in place in the event you require immediate transportation. If you have questions about the medical forms you received, please contact the school nurse for assistance.

CELLPHONES

All cellphones are prohibited!

First offense: If a student is found in possession of a cell phone during the school day it will be confiscated and **ONLY** released to a parent/guardian.

Second Offense: If a student is found in possession of a cell phone during the school day it will be confiscated and will **NOT** be returned for 30 calendar days. (If the 30th day falls on a weekend or vacation time it will be returned on the first day returning to school only to the parent/guardian).

Third Offense: Cell phone will be held until the **LAST DAY** of the school year and returned only to the parent/guardian.

There are **NO EXCEPTIONS** to this! This includes any additional phones or "burner" phones.

Students will be periodically electronically scanned, without notice, to check for contraband and for security purposes. Leave unnecessary items **HOME**. The staff and school are not responsible for lost, stolen, damaged, or misplaced personal items your child brings to school.

BREAKFAST AND LUNCHES

The U.S. Department of Agriculture will provide students lunches at reduced or free cost. If you qualify for a Free or Reduced Lunch the proper paperwork must be submitted to determine your eligibility. You should have received this information already. If not, please contact the main office for a copy or go to our website www.warrenglenacademy.com and click on "What's for Lunch", where you will find the application and lunch menu. Applications are to be returned to the school nurse.

Breakfast cost \$2.75

Lunch cost \$4.10 per meal

Milk is .75 cents Juice is .60 cents

Payments for breakfast and lunch can be paid at the beginning or at the end of the month.

Checks are to be made to "Warren Glen Academy". If a check 'bounces' for insufficient funds, there is a \$35.00 returned check fee. Any unused monies will be returned at the end of the school year.

SAFETY/SECURITY/WELL-BEING

School safety and security remain a primary concern for educational institutions. We ask that you remain vigilant with whom your child is with as well as his/her/their access or possession of harmful materials/weapons. (This INCLUDES inappropriate websites and social media). Please be reminder, that while a police officer requires Probable Cause, school employees only require Reasonable Suspicion to search a student and their belongings. This includes clothing, backpacks, desks, lockers, lunch bags, and on-line profile, etc. (strip searches are strictly prohibited). While this is not to be interpreted as anything more than information for your knowledge, it is necessary to monitor what your child brings to school and has access to when at home or being transported to school. This is another example of how we collaborate to avoid unnecessary conflicts/confrontations to support a harmonious school environment.

Each month we are required by law to hold safety and security drills (fire drills, shelter in place drills, and lockdown drills). These measures are practiced so that your child knows what to expect during a drill, and how to safely respond in the event of an emergency. Parents will always be given notice of when a drill has been practiced at school.

BACK-TO-SCHOOL NIGHT

Thursday, September 25 is our annual Back to School Night at 6:30 pm. This is also an Early Dismissal Day at 12:15 p.m.

We look forward to seeing you to introduce you to our staff and review our programs with you. Please mark your calendar and join us for this meet and greet night at our school.

Please note unfortunately we are unable to provide childcare for students or siblings during Back – To – School night.
