

Welcome Our New Executive Director

Warren Glen Academy is proud to welcome **Mr. Nicholas Cammarano** as our new **Executive Director**, effective **July 1, 2026**.

Entering his 30th year in education, Mr. Cammarano brings extensive experience as both an educator and administrator. His career includes **21 years as a classroom teacher** and **8 years in school leadership**, serving students in public, private, and charter school settings from **PreK through Grade 12**.

Mr. Cammarano earned both his **Bachelor of Arts in Education and History** and his **Master's Degree in Educational Leadership** from **Monmouth University**.

He began his teaching career in 1997 at Saint Benedict School in Holmdel as a sixth-grade teacher. In 1998, he joined Frank Antonides School in West Long Branch, where he spent the next 20 years teaching fourth, fifth, and sixth grades. During his tenure, he was recognized as the **West Long Branch School District Teacher of the Year** in 2008.

Mr. Cammarano began his administrative career in 2018 at University Heights Charter School in Newark, where he served in progressively responsible leadership positions, including supervisor, assistant principal, and principal of grades four and five. In 2020, he joined Perth Amboy Public Schools as Assistant Principal for both the Alternative High School (Personalized Learning Program) and the Adult and Continuing Education programs. During the COVID-19 pandemic, he worked tirelessly to ensure students remained on track to earn the credits needed to graduate with their classmates. He later served as Assistant Principal of Shull Middle School, supporting more than 1,400 students in grades five and six.

In 2023, Mr. Cammarano returned to Saint Benedict School as Principal. Under his leadership, school enrollment increased by more than 20 percent, helping establish Saint Benedict School as one of the most sought-after schools within the Diocese of Trenton.

Throughout his career, Mr. Cammarano has been dedicated to creating welcoming, supportive learning environments where every student has the opportunity to succeed. He values strong relationships with students, families, staff, and the community and believes that collaboration is the foundation of educational excellence.
